

## Future Scientists and Mathematicians at SmaE!










There is always great excitement around the school when we hold a themed week. This was certainly the case for both Maths Week and Science Week!








The 5th class have begun preparing for the uncaming Vex Rabatics Competition

very carefully.








The 4th Class were busy mathematicians in the halla during their Maths Week stations. The children had a new challenge at each station and worked hard to solve them both individually and together.
